How can you use bokashi liquid as an organic drain cleaner?

Did you know that the bokashi liquid can be used in two ways? Aside from being used as an awe-some natural fertilizer substitute, there is another use case for it. Thanks to its highly acidic nature and the beneficial microorganisms it contains, it is a very effective organic drain cleaning agent. As such, you can clean your drains with it once per week.

Using bokashi liquid as a drain cleaner is very easy; you simply drain the juice from your bokashi bin using a cup or a glass and then pour it down the drain. In this case, you use it undiluted. After pouring bokashi liquid down your drains, let it rest for a couple of hours. Then use hot water to rinse the drains. That's it! We told you it was very simple! And you can do this on all your drains.

Aside from keeping your drains clean and bad smell free, you will also introduce beneficial microorganisms into the piping system, where they will fight pathogens. Moreover, in the case of septic tanks, this also means that your septic tank will be healthier. And by healthier, we mean less smelly and environmentally non-invasive. Imagine how it would be if everyone in the block of flats would use the bokashi liquid for cleaning drains! What a clean neighborhood this would be.
